



3-D SALT PAINTING



Supplies

- Cardboard or heavy paper
- Elmers Glue
- Table Salt
- Watercolor/Food Coloring (If you're using food coloring, make sure to dilute it with a couple drops of water.)

Process

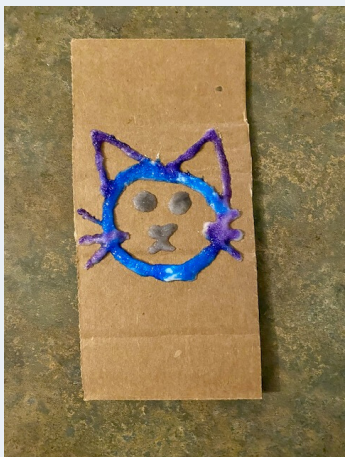
- Draw your design in glue on your cardboard.
- Cover all the glue with table salt and pour extra off of the cardboard.
- Wait for the glue to dry.
- Using watercolor or food coloring, add droplets of color to the dried glue. The color should spread and create a 3-D paint effect!
