



MAKE YOUR OWN VIEWFINDER



Composition and Viewpoint

Composition: the placement of the elements (other than the subject) in a work of art.

Viewpoint: the position from which the viewer is looking at the subject of the work of art. For example, if the subject is a boat on the ocean, the viewer could be looking at it from a distance, or from up close.

Process

- Glue four popsicle sticks together into a square.
- After that dries, glue six pieces of string into a grid on the square.
- Once this dries, hold your viewfinder up to the scene you'd like to draw or paint. This will help you create the composition of your piece as well as understand the viewpoint.
