



WATERCOLOR RESIST CIRCLE ART



Supplies:

- White Construction Paper
- Watercolor paints & brushes
- A large roll of tape or other round object for tracing
- A white crayon

Procedure:

1. Using your roll of tape and white crayon, trace circles on your construction paper. They can overlap!
2. Once you've covered the whole page with circles, fill them in using your watercolors! The wax from the crayon should create a barrier that prevents the watercolor from spreading. This technique is called watercolor resist! This will create a fun & colorful abstract work of art!
